



The remains of the shipyard created for the construction of warships by the Hagi (Choshu) domain. In the late Edo period, 2 Westernstyle warships constructed here were launched


bMount. Kasayama Camellia Grove

GHagi Reverberatory **Furnace**




A metallurgical furnace invented in Europe. There are only three such sites in all Japan, and as such, these remains are very significant.
